Admissions Requirements:

A bachelor's degree in nursing (BSN) with a cumulative GPA of 2.8 is required.

Professional resume or curriculum vitae; an equivalent of one full-time year of experience as a registered nurse by the time you start your first practicum course.

Time to Completion*
